Adiantum Raddianum

Light requirements:
Light shade or dappled sunlight.

Soil requirements:Moist.

Use:
Maidenhair fern.

Additional comments:Grown for foliage.



Aglaonema

Light requirements:
Thrives in poor light areas.

Growth:
Slow growing.

Soil requirements:
Moist.

Use:
Popular varieties include 'Silver Queen' and 'Silver King'.

Additional comments:Grown for its foliage.



Alocasia Reginula

Light requirements:
Bright indirect light.

Growth:
Will grow 30cm.

Toxicity:
Toxic if eaten.

Disease/s:
May suffer from mealy bug and aphids.

Additional comments:
Will rot from base if over wet.



Alocasia Sanderiana

Light requirements:
Bright indirect light.

Growth:
Leaves will grow 40cm long.

Soil requirements:
Moist.

Toxicity:
Toxic if eaten.

Disease/s:
May suffer from mealy bug & aphids.

Additional comments:
Grown for foliage.



Anthurium Scherzerianum

Light requirements:
Bright spot but no direct sunlight.

Growth:
Grows 40cm tall.

Soil requirements:
Moist.

Additional comments:
Flowering from Spring to late summer.



Asparagus aethiopicus

Light requirements:
Bright or semi-shade.

Growth:
Leaf stems grow up to 90cm.

Use:
Asparagus Fern is the most popular variety.

Additional comments:

Can flower white / pale pink on mature plants. Grown for foliage.



Asplenium Nidus

Light requirements:
Shade to bright light, no direct light.

Growth:
Can grow 60cm.

Soil requirements:
Moist but don't overwater.

Disease/s:
Can be prone to scale insect.



Aucuba Japonica Variegata

Light requirements:
Bright or shade, no direct sunlight.

Use:
Grown for foliage.

Additional comments:

Only variegated varieties to be used indoors. Must be kept in check by pruning.



Begonia Escargot

Light requirements:
Bright indirect light.

Growth:
Can grow to 50cm long.

Soil requirements:
Moist but not over wet.

Disease/s:
Mealy bug, aphids, thrips and powdery mildew maybe an issue.

Use:
Grown for foliage.



Begonia rex

Light requirements:Bright indirect light.

Growth:
Will grow 60cm long.

Soil requirements:Moist.

Use:
Grown for foliage.



Calathea Corona

Light requirements:
Bright light but not direct sunlight.

Growth:
Grow 50cm tall.

Soil requirements: Moist but not over wet.

Use:
Grown for foliage

Additional comments: Very similar to Marantas ingrowing conditions.



Calathea Dottie

Growth:
Grows 30cm-45cm so must be pruned to keep in checks.

Disease/s:
Fungus, aphids, mealy bug, spider mite & scale may be an issue if not treated.

Use:
Grown for foliage.

Additional comments:

Easy to grow plant. Selectively prune off larger leaves to promote air flow.



Calathea Lancifolia

Growth:

Grows 30cm-45cm so must be pruned to keep in checks.

Disease/s:

Fungus, aphids, mealy bug, spider mite & scale may be an issue if not treated.

Use:

Grown for foliage.

Additional comments:

Easy to grow plant. Selectively prune off larger leaves to promote air flow.

Growth:

Will grow 60cm-90cm so must be kept pruned.

Use:

Grown for foliage.

Additional comments:

Easy to grow plant. Selectively prune off larger leaves to promote air flow.



Calathea Orbifolia

Growth:

Will grow 60cm-90cm so must be kept pruned.

Use:

Grown for foliage.

Additional comments:

Easy to grow plant. Selectively prune off larger leaves to promote air flow.

Growth:

Will grow 60cm so must be kept pruned.

Growth:

Will grow 30cm-45cm so must be kept pruned.

Use:

Grown for foliage.

Chamaedorea Elegans

Light requirements:

Bright area but no direct light.

Growth:

Very slow growing.

Soil requirements:

Moist but not over wet.

Disease/s:

Prone to spider mite and thrips.



Chlorophytum comosum

Light requirements:

Bright area away from direct sunlight.

Growth:

Will grow in hot or cool rooms.

Soil requirements:

Moist.

Use:

Grown for foliage.



Codiaeum

Light requirements: Bright area.

Soil requirements: Moist.

Use:

Grown for foliage.

Additional comments: Keep in a warm area. Excellent air cleaner.



Crassula Ovata

Light requirements:
Likes full sun.

Growth:
Very slow growing.

Disease/s:
Prone to aphids & vine weevil.

Additional comments: Fleshy leaves.



Dieffenbachia

Light requirements:
Bright indirect light.

Growth:
Must be prune to keep shape as can grow 150cm.

Soil requirements:
Moist.



Dischidia ruscifolia

Light requirements:
Bright indirect light.

Growth:
Trailing plant which grows 45cm long.

Use:
Foliage is succulent like.

Additional comments:
Produces fragrant flowers in the summer.



Epipremum Aureum

Light requirements:
Prefers partial shade.

Growth:
Can grow 4m long so keep pruned.

Use:
Trailing / climbing plant.

Additional comments: Excellent air cleaning plant.



Fatsia Japonica

Light requirements:
Bright area.

Growth:
Fast growing.

Use:
Grown for foliage, flowers rarely appear.

Additional comments:
Must be pruned to keep size.



- Ferns



Ficus Pumila

Light requirements:
Prefers partial shade.

Growth:
Needs to be kept pruned or can get out of control.

Use:
Trailing plant.

Additional comments:
Small leaves, good for background



Fittonia

Light requirements:
Indirect bright light.

Growth:
Slow growing.

Soil requirements:
Moist but not soggy.

Use:
Grown for foliage. Large variety of colours.

Additional comments: Low growing and can get over shadowed.



Maranta Arundinacea Rubra

Light requirements:

Bright light but not direct sunlight.

Soil requirements:

Keep the soil moist but not overly wet, with a PH of about 6.5.

Disease/s:

Fungus, mealy bugs & aphids can be an issue (treat on the first signs).

Additional comments:

Almost all Marantas are treated the same.



Maranta Leuconeura

Growth:

Usually grows about 30cm tall.

Use:

Grown for foliage.

Additional comments:

Easy to grow plant. Selectively prune off larger leaves to promote air flow.



Maranta Tricolor

Growth:

Usually grows about 30cm tall.

Use:

Great for coverage and colour.

Additional comments:

Easy to grow plant. Selectively prune off larger leaves to promote air flow.



Monstera Deliciosa

Light requirements:

Bright indirect light.

Growth:

Leaves will grow 90cm so must be kept pruned.

Soil requirements:

Moist but not over wet.

Disease/s:

Mealy bugs, spider mites, thrips & scale may be an issue.



Nephrolepis Cordifolia Duffii

Light requirements:

Light shade.

Growth:

Grows 30cm long and wide.

Soil requirements:

Moist.

Additional comments:

Foliage can have a lemon scent.



Nephrolepis Exaltata

Light requirements:

Prefers light shade.

Soil requirements:

Moist.

Disease/s:

Generally pest free.

Additional comments:

Must be kept in check as they can easily over shadow other plants.



Pellaea Rotundifolia

Growth:

Stems grow 30cm.

Soil requirements:

Prefers slightly dry.

Additional comments:

Easy to grow. Shiny leaflets.



Philodendron Scandens

Light requirements:

Thrives in bright light but can survive in shade.

Growth:

Will grow 4m long.

Use:

Trailing plant.

Additional comments:

Scale insect, thrips & spider mites may be an issue.



Phlebodium Aureum

Light requirements:
Bright area but no direct sunlight.

Growth:
Can grow around 90cm long.

Soil requirements:
Moist.

Use:
Can add good contrast to the wall.

Additional comments:
Blue/grey coloured fern.



Rhipsalis Cassutha

Light requirements:
Bright indirect light but can take full sun.

Growth:
Will grow 180cm so must be kept pruned.

Soil requirements:
Water sparingly.



Saxifraga Stonifera

Light requirements:
Prefers shade.

Growth:
Can grow 30cm wide.

Disease/s:
Prone to spider mite attack.

Use:
Grown for foliage rather than flower.

Additional comments:
Best grown in a mixed planting plan.



Scindapsus Pictus

Light requirements:
Bright indirect light.

Growth:
Will grow 150cm long.

Soil requirements:
Moist.

Disease/s:
Generally pest and disease free.

Use:
Trailing plant.



Soleirolia Soleirolii

Light requirements:
Prefers shade over full sun.

Growth:
Can spread almost indefinitely to produce a carpet effect.

Soil requirements:
Moist.

Additional comments:
Must be kept in check or it will over shadow other plants.



Spathiphyllum Wallisii

Light requirements:
Prefers a bright area but away from direct sunlight.

Soil requirements:
Moist, do not let it dry out.

Additional comments:
Easy to grow.
Excellent at cleaning the air. Important to use 'Wallisii' variety as others are too big for living walls.



Syngonium Podophyllum

Light requirements:
Bright area but no direct sunlight.

Growth:
Trailing / climbing plant grows 1.8m.

Additional comments: Excellent at cleaning air.

All parts are poisonous, keep out of reach of children / pets.



Tradescantia Zebrina

Light requirements:
Full sun or light shade.

Growth:
Trailing plant can grow 50cm

Soil requirements:
Moist, but not over wet

Use:
Grown for foliage rather than flower.

Additional comments:
Keep reasonably pruned to keep it from looking leggy.
